



Safety Data Sheet (SDS): CGX™ Lupulin Hop Pellets

CGX™ Lupulin Hop Pellets by Crosby Hops is a line of cryogenically processed lupulin pellets designed to enhance hop flavor and aroma in brewing. CGX™ utilizes a proprietary cryogenic process to separate and concentrate lupulin from dried, whole leaf hop cones. CGX™ Hop Pellets are produced in accordance with US FDA regulation 21 CFR 170.30(c) and 170.3(f) and are generally recognized as safe (GRAS). CGX Hop Pellets are not classified as a hazard under the European Union GHS Classification & Labeling of Chemicals Regulation (EC) No. 1272/2008, Directive 67/548/EEC.

2. Hazards Identification

Hazard Classification: None

Oral ingestion: Associated dust may be irritating to mouth and throat

Eye contact: Associated dust may be irritating to eyes

3. Composition/Information on Ingredients

Components: 100% by weight pelleted hop cones of the cultivated hop plant *Humulus lupulus*.

4. First Aid Measures

Inhalation: Remove affected individual away from area into fresh air



Skin contact: Brush off excess material and wash skin thoroughly with soap and water if irritation occurs

Eye contact: Flood the eye with plenty of water if irritation occurs. Seek medical attention if irritation persists

Oral ingestion: Drink large amounts of milk or water to dilute if irritation occurs. Vomiting may occur. Consult a physician

5. Fire-Fighting Measures

Extinguishing media: Use dry powder, foam or carbon dioxide. Keep containers and surroundings cool with water spray

Special firefighting procedures: Great care should be taken using water jet/spray. Unusual fire and explosion hazards: No known unusual fire or explosion hazards

6. Accidental Release Measures

Personal protection: Wear appropriate protective clothing to prevent possible irritation from dust; safety glasses, respirator if in confined area, and rubber gloves.

Environmental precautions: Do not allow products to enter drains to avoid potential for clogging of drain due to high oil content/ water insolubility of product

Methods for cleaning up: Normal clean-up procedures for any agricultural commodity

7. Handling and Storage

Handling: Avoid generating excessive dust

Storage: To guarantee quality, avoid exposure to heat, moisture, and strong odors. Pellets should be stored in a cool, dry and odor-free environment between 24°F (-4°C). Pellets should not be exposed to temperatures above 20°C (68°F) to prevent gas formation from hop constituents. The resulting pressure increase upon gas formation may cause bursting of the storage package, exposing the pellets to air, resulting in oxidation and considerable deterioration of product quality. Suitable storage containers are thick gauge laminated foil/Mylar bags, stainless steel and lacquered mild steel
